



As we celebrate the UN-FAO's International Year of Family Farming, it is most fitting that the 2014 World Food Prize Laureate is an individual who has truly fulfilled Dr. Norman Borlaug's last words: "Take it to the Farmer."

As a young scientist, Dr. Sanjaya Rajaram worked closely with Dr. Borlaug in field research and later became head of CIMMYT's wheat breeding program. During his career he developed 480 high-yielding, disease and stress resistant wheat varieties that have been grown on 58 million hectares in 51 countries, increasing total global wheat production by more than 200 million tons.



40 CHANCES FELLOWS

In October 2013, former Prime Minister Tony Blair, Howard G. Buffett and World Food Prize President Amb. Kenneth M. Quinn announced the 40 Chances Fellows program to encourage market-based initiatives that reduce food insecurity, conflict or poverty in Rwanda, Malawi, Liberia and Sierra Leone. At the 2014 Borlaug Dialogue, four young social entrepreneurs under the age of 40 will be awarded \$150,000 each to launch and implement their proposals.


