

AMBASSADOR KENNETH QUINN WORLD FOOD PRIZE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

IOWA YOUTH INSTITUTE (\$1,000)

lowa residents completing the World Food Prize lowa Youth Institute at Iowa State earn a \$500 scholarship for each institute. This is in addition to any scholarships offered by the Office of Admission, the Collegeof Agriculture and Life Sciences (CALS)* or the department of their selected major. Ambassador Kenneth Quinn World Food Prize Scholarships are renewable for a student's second year in CALS for a \$1,000 total award.

GLOBAL YOUTH INSTITUTE (\$2,000)

Students completing the World Food Prize Global Youth Institute automatically earn a \$1,000 scholarship that can be renewed for a second year. This is in addition to other scholarships they are offered by Iowa State.

BORLAUG-RUAN INTERNATIONAL INTERNSHIP (\$6,000)

Any student completing a Borlaug-Ruan International internship will automatically earn a \$3,000 scholarship for each summer they intern that can be renewed for a second year. In addition, for high school seniors completing their internship the summer prior to entry, the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences offers priority summer orientation options.

*Students should include World Food Prize activities as leadership positions on scholarship applications for preferred consideration.
