As a prominent feature of the International Borlaug Dialogue, side events provide a space for organizations and initiatives to coordinate and execute their own unique event in conjunction with the Dialogue. Virtual Side Event Host Organizers design these gatherings to demonstrate work, promote further dialogue, and engage attendees through hosted events, panels, receptions and announcements.

The 2021 International Borlaug Dialogue (*October 20 - 22*) will be offered in a hybrid format. INTERNATIONAL BORLAUG DIALOGUE THEME

Twenty-twenty brought many challenges to and opportunities for working in the <u>Decade of Action</u> towards the <u>UN Sustainable Development Goals</u>. Communities worldwide faced unprecedented barriers to meeting food security needs with at least <u>20 countries on the brink of famine</u>, highlighting the importance of global collective action. As we continue to move forward in this decade of action towards the UN Food Systems Summit and other global convenings, we have the opportunity to *gain momentum* as never before. We recognize that we cannot 'reboot' the system, but must *transform* food systems to right inequitable structures.

This pivotal year offers milestones for international collaboration. The International Borlaug Dialogue follows the UN Food Systems Summit (FSS) and the 48th Committee on World Food Security while **building forward** for COP26 and the Nutrition for Growth Summit, to gain momentum in the Decade of Action. Country commitments and Coalitions of Action adopted during the UN FSS will be highlighted during the Borlaug Dialogue, reaching additional audiences and widening opportunities for partnership.

OUTLINE OF PARTNER RESPONSIBILITIES Content

- Virtual Side Event Host Organizers are solely responsible for the cultivation of the Side Event's content, including speakers.
- World Food Prize Foundation staff will assist in supporting the development of the content of Side Events.
- Please note that there is not a requirement for Side Events to align with the theme of the International Borlaug Dialogue.

Platform And Registration

- The procurement of a virtual platform is the responsibility of the Virtual Side Event Host Organizers.
- Expenses incurred related to technical or production related support are the sole responsibility of the Virtual Side Event Host Organizer.
- Virtual Side Event Host Organizers are responsible for the production and oversight of the virtual platform of their choice.
- If desired, Virtual Side Event Host Organizers will be responsible for managing a registration platform of their choice.



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PARTNER RESPONSIBILITIES CONTINUED

Communications

- Promotion and direct correspondence with International Borlaug Dialogue attendees, per the weekly attendee list, is the responsibility of the Virtual Side Event Host Organizer.
- Virtual Side Event Host Organizers are encouraged to promote their event publicly. Registration to the International Borlaug Dialogue is not required of virtual Side Event attendees.
- Any additional promotion or cross-promotion with the International Borlaug Dialogue is welcomed.
