

2025 Borlaug-Ruan International Internship Parent / Guardian Consent Form

The Borlaug-Ruan International Internship program provides promising young leaders a unique professional research and work experience with the leading international organizations in food, nutrition, agriculture and development in Africa, Asia, the Americas, Europe, and the Middle East.

Eligibility: Any student who has participated in, volunteered for, or has other involvement with a World Food Prize Foundation program and is between the ages of 17 - 20 years old (on June 1, 2025) is eligible to apply.

The program differs from other study abroad and internship programs in that the students complete original research projects alongside World Food Prize and Nobel Laureates, and work with acclaimed international scientists, practitioners, and policymakers in the field to improve food security and solve the most pressing agricultural, nutritional, health, economic and environmental problems around the world. The intern becomes an integral member of their team, spending significant time in the laboratory, in the field, or in local communities conducting research and gathering data.

There is no fee to apply or participate, and the World Food Prize Foundation and host organizations will provide the intern research project, weekly mentorship and supervision, and access to specialized training, and cultural immersion experiences. Borlaug-Ruan International Interns will be required to commit to a full-time, in-person international internship which requires an 8-week minimum commitment during the summer of 2025, during which they will not return home unless in case of emergency. Specific dates will be determined with host organizations, if selected. This is an unpaid internship. For more information, go to www.worldfoodprize.org/BR.
