IOWA STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS.

AMBASSADOR KENNETH QUINN WORLD FOOD PRIZE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM:

IOWA YOUTH INSTITUTE (\$1,000)

Iowa residents completing the World Food Prize Iowa Youth Institute at Iowa State earn a \$500 scholarship for each institute. This is in addition to any scholarships offered by the Office of Admission, the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences (CALs)* or the department of their selected major. Ambassador Kenneth Quinn World Food Prize Scholarships are renewable for a student's second year in CALs for a \$1,000 total award.

GLOBAL YOUTH INSTITUTE (\$2,000)

Students completing the World Food Prize Global Youth Institute automatically earn a \$1,000 scholarship that can be renewed for a second year. This is in addition to other scholarships they are offered by Iowa State.

BORLAUG-RUAN INTERNATIONAL INTERNSHIP (\$6,000)

Any student completing a Borlaug-Ruan International internship will automatically earn a \$3,000 scholarship for each summer they intern that can be renewed for a second year. In addition, for high school seniors completing their internship the summer prior to entry, the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences offers priority summer orientation options.

*Students should include World Food Prize activities as leadership positions on scholarship applications for preferred consideration.

IMPORTANT SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Iowa State offers awards to students who fulfill specific academic requirements. The awards are automatically awarded to students who have been offered admission to Iowa State. See www.admissions.iastate.edu/scholarships/freshman for details. Students will not be penalized due to lack of an ACT or SAT score. Students with a test score below the minimum scholarship requirements will also be individually reviewed.

Renewal requirements: student must remain continuously enrolled at Iowa State on a full-time basis in good academic standing with a minimum of 12 credits per semester, be assessed resident tuition and maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.
