Frequently Asked Questions

- **What is the cost to participate in DialogueNEXT?**
 - There is no cost for attendees to register or organizations to be standard exhibitors.
- **Where is the conference taking place?**
 - The conference will be held in Nairobi, Kenya, at the [Safari Park Hotel](#) in the [Jambo Conference Center](#). Immersions will take place at various locations in Nairobi. Please stand by for more information.
- **What airport options are convenient?**
 - Kenya's main international airport is the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi (Airport code: NBO).
- **How do I get to the event venue from the airport without a personal vehicle?**
 - The Safari Park Hotel offers convenient and secure airport transfers using branded vehicles for individuals and groups. Rates are as follows: a 25-seater bus (\$200 one way), a van for up to five passengers (\$85 one way) and a saloon car for up to three passengers (\$42 one way). Accommodation bookings and airport transfer arrangements are managed directly through the hotel's reservations office and **will be offered via email to guests who reserve a hotel room at the Safari Park Hotel**.
 - Attendees may take a taxi or use ride-hailing services and should avoid accepting rides from unverified individuals or entering unidentified vehicles. It is also recommended to confirm the driver's identity and vehicle details before starting the journey and to agree on the fare in advance if the service is not metered or app-based.
 - The journey typically takes 30 to 50 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.
- **How do I book a room at the Safari Park Hotel?**
 1. Click [here](#) to go to the booking page.
 2. Select the "Login" located at the top right corner of the page.
 3. Enter the following credentials to sign in:

 4. Once logged in, click on "Check Availability" to view available rooms.



- **What documentation is required to enter Kenya?**
 - Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) information, which may be required depending on an individual's country of citizenship, can be found [here](#).
 - A yellow fever vaccination certificate is generally required for entry into Kenya if an attendee is arriving from or has recently traveled to a country with risk of yellow fever transmission.
- **What is the best address to use in a navigation app or GPS to get to the venue?**
 - Safari Park Hotel & Casino, Kasarani off Thika Road, P.O. Box 45038 - 00100, Nairobi, Kenya.
- **Can I park at the venue?**
 - Yes, ample free parking is available at the Safari Park Hotel.
- **What is required to enter the event?**
 - All guests are required to register on the [World Food Prize Foundation website](#). Upon arrival, all pre-registered attendees must check in at the registration desk at the venue and collect their badge. A government-issued ID and first and last name is required at check-in. Badges are required for access to all event spaces.
- **What is the recommended attire for this event?**
 - Business professional and ethnic attire are welcomed.
- **Are there opportunities to exhibit at the event?**
 - Organizations can learn more about hosting an exhibit booth [here](#). For standard exhibitors, there is no fee. For premium exhibitors, there is a fee.
- **Will the event be live streamed?**
 - No, but recordings of the sessions will be made available on the Foundation's YouTube page [here](#) after the event.
- **What is the power supply?**
 - Travelers should bring an adapter compatible with type G outlets. The standard voltage is 240 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. It is advisable to check the voltage compatibility of your devices—especially high-wattage equipment—before traveling.



- **What will the weather be like at the time of DialogueNEXT?**
 - Nairobi is expected to have mild and dry weather, typical of its coolest time of the year. Guests can expect comfortable days with partly cloudy skies. Daytime temperatures are typically around 73 degrees Fahrenheit (22.8 Celsius) with cooler evening temperatures.

- **What health precautions should I take before traveling to Kenya?**
 - Attendees are encouraged to consult their healthcare provider or a travel clinic prior to departure to discuss recommended vaccinations and medications. In addition to yellow fever (if applicable), routine vaccinations may be recommended depending on your travel history and planned activities.
 - Attendees should bring any personal prescription medications in their original packaging, along with a copy of the prescription. It is also advisable to carry basic over-the-counter medications (e.g., pain relievers, anti-diarrheal medication, antihistamines) and hand sanitizer.

- **Are there medical facilities near the venue?**
 - Yes, Nairobi has several reputable hospitals and clinics within a short driving distance of the Safari Park Hotel. The hotel staff can assist in arranging medical care if needed. Comprehensive travel health insurance, including coverage for medical care and emergency evacuation, is **not** provided by the conference organizers and is recommended for all attendees.
