- Where is the conference taking place?
 The conference will be held at the <u>Bharat Ratna C. Subramaniam Auditorium</u> of the <u>ICAR Convention Center</u> at the National Agricultural Science Complex (NASC).
- Are there recommendations for hotel accommodations near the conference venue?
 - The recommended conference hotel is the **Taj Palace** in New Delhi.
 - Address: Taj Palace, 2, Sardar Patel Marg, Diplomatic Enclave, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi 110021.
 - There are no pre-arranged room blocks or transportation at the following suggested hotels.
 - <u>Hotel The Royal Plaza</u> at 19, Ashoka Road, Connaught Place, New Delhi 110001
 - <u>Hotel Ginger</u> at Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu and Lakshadweep Bhawan, 13A-16D, Tikendrajit Marg, Chanakyapuri, Delhi 110021 (Indian Nationals Only).
- What airport options are convenient?
 - The most convenient option is Indira Gandhi International Airport in New Delhi (airport code: DEL).
- How do I get to the event venue from the airport without a personal vehicle?
 - From the airport, attendees may take a taxi or use ride-hailing services such as Uber or Ola. It is strongly recommended using services arranged inside the airport rather than hailing taxis on the street. The journey typically takes 45 to 60 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

Can I park on ICAR premises?

 Yes, parking is available at the ICAR Convention Center. However, due to the expected number of participants, we recommend arriving via local taxi or a ride-hailing service.

What is required to enter the event?

 Upon arrival, all pre-registered attendees must check in at the registration desk at the venue and collect their badge. A first and last name is required at check-in. Badges are required for access to all event spaces.

What will the weather be like?

 September is the end of the monsoon season in New Delhi. Temperatures typically range between 30 to 35 °C (86 to 95 °F).

What is the recommended attire for this event?

o Business professional and ethnic attire is welcomed.

Will the event be live streamed?

 No, but recordings of the sessions will be made available on the World Food Prize Foundation's YouTube page <u>here</u> after the event.

What is the power supply?

 India uses a 220V power supply at a frequency of 50Hz. Attendees should bring a travel adapter compatible with plug types C, D or M. It is advisable to check the voltage compatibility of your devices—especially high-voltage equipment—before traveling.

- For your safety, please exercise caution and review safety recommendations before travel. It is recommended to avoid traveling on foot after dark and remain vigilant in public streets.
